



## Mr. Clarence Carl Hubbell

June 26, 1938 - October 20, 2016

Services for Mr. C. Carl Hubbell, 78, of Gilmer will be held on a later date, a private family burial was held at Glenwood Cemetery in Upshur County.

Mr. Hubbell passed away October 20, 2016, aged 78 years, 3 months, and 24 days in Longview, Texas.
