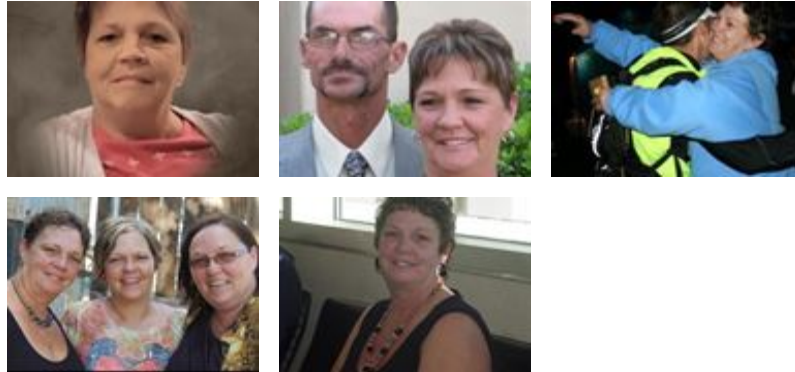
A private memorial gathering will be held by her family. Arrangements are under the direction of McWhorter Funeral Home.
