Funeral services for Georgia Ann James Duke will be held at 2:00 pm, Monday, December 22, 2025, in the Chapel of McWhorter Funeral Home with Brother Charles Johnson officiating. Private interment will follow at Little Mound Cemetery. The family will receive friends at 1:00 pm prior to the service.

Georgia Ann James Duke was born on September 23, 1935, in Gilmer, Texas, to Washington Sherman James and Nettie Lou Langford James. A bright and dedicated student, she graduated as Valedictorian of Harmony High School. Georgia went on to build a long and respected career at Gilmer National Bank, where she faithfully served her community for more than 20 years. She passed from this earth and went to be with her heavenly Father on December 13, 2025.

Georgia's life was deeply rooted in faith, family, and music. She was an active member of Little Mound Baptist Church, where she sang in "The Little Mound Quartet". Her love for gospel music led her to join "The Harmonettes," a beloved group that traveled throughout the East Texas area, sharing joy and inspiration through song. She is lovingly remembered by her seven great-grandchildren.
