“ Mike and I were best friends when growing up in Rosewood. We were in the same class at Harmony for 12 years. We ran up and down the roads in this part of Upshur County on our bicycles and later ran around together in cars.

Mike often appeared quiet on the outside but he really had an outgoing personality once he got to know you better.

During our last football game in 1969, we played Union Grove at their stadium. Harmony had never beaten UG on their field at that time. Mike played end, and he and I teamed up for a TD pass in the game. Richard James ran back an interception for a TD in this game, and when the game ended, we had won 30-20. I have always treasured this memory.

The best thing that ever happened to Mike occurred during our senior year. He was sweet on Joyce McNeil. Joyce and her family lived in the house now occupied by Margaret Robertson. Their family were regular church attenders, so Mike started coming to church at Rosewood even though his family attended Little Mound.

One Sunday night after the last "Amen," Mike made a bee-line to Pastor Carl Acker who was standing at the entrance and told him he wanted to be saved and baptized. He asked Jesus into his heart and was baptized by Bro. Acker. Because of this event in his earthly life, I look expectantly forward to spending eternity with him in glory.
