



## Norman Theodore Hastings

February 2, 1937 - June 2, 2024

Memorial services for Norman Theodore Hastings, 87, of Gilmer, Texas, will be held at 2:00 pm, Wednesday, June 5, 2024, at First Methodist Church, Gilmer, with Reverend Matthew Smith officiating. Norman was born on February 2, 1937, to Alton Theodore Hastings and Evangeline Agnes Pierce Hastings in Independence, Kansas, and passed from this life on June 2, 2024, surrounded by his family.

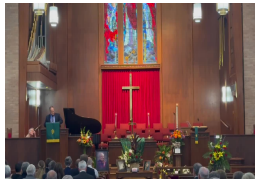
