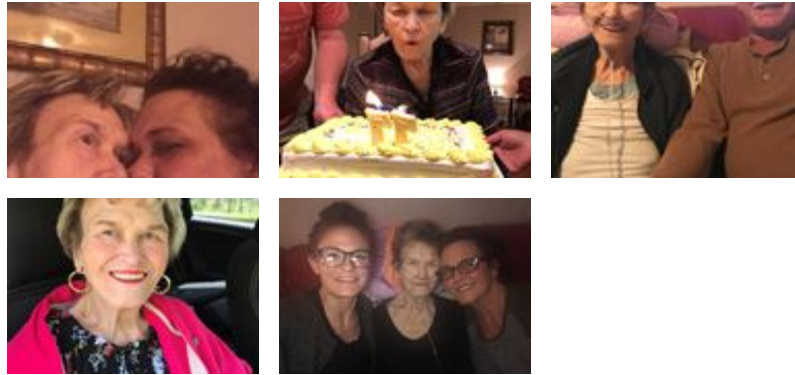

And when we were at the restaurant we made so much noise I would say we were the loudest table in there. Then after that we would all pile in our car and usually one sister was in charge of where we would start of first to the garage sales marked down and off we went. Now when 5 girls get out of the car at the same time running toward items we have already spotted from the car. I believe we scared half of the people that had the garage sales. And everybody that had the garage sales would say are y'all sisters. All I know is that was a blast. I have so many fond memories of Priscilla that I actually could go on and on. I will miss my sister very much. I will miss her laugh, I will miss her kindness, I will miss the way she loved her children and her husband. But God has an angel in heaven and I know I will see her again.*
