Terry always referred me as "The Toolman" because I always carried my tools and always doing something out and about on our Deer Lease, building a stand or working around our Deer Cabin. Well this one weekend in early spring I was making a place for our 4 - wheelers so we could leave them out there instead of bringing them home after each trip. It was early, around 8am and we were all just finishing drinking coffee and telling everyone how ugly we look after getting up and so forth, just being sarcastic to everybody, just a guy thing, try and get you going with some early laughs and I wanted to get an early start building before it got hot and everyone else was going to tend to there projects too.

I was already in the back of cabin cutting and building before everyone else had left when I over heard Terry telling everyone not to take off with his 4 - wheeler and leave him with the Toolman because I would put him to work.

Well you guessed it, they all left and took his 4 - wheeler leaving him behind, so Terry came around back so I could have some company and so he wouldn't be so bored on the porch by himself. He was busy watching me measure and cut and build, always talking and asking me questions, "What's that for, what are you doing now, how come you're doing it that way, and "my mind was telling me, like he really had a clue" and I'd try to give him answers to all his questions, then he became quite as we had already been back there 2 or 3 hours already, then he started in again asking questions, kinda of like he had gotten his second wind and ready to go again and I responded back to him, "any help he could offer or give would be better than just sitting there looking "Stupid"! I had gotten one of the best ones ever on Terry after that moment. One that would stand till the end of time with Terry and myself.

Of course, we just laughed at the moment like we always had, but you better have thick skin out on the deer Lease, because you will be tested every day and once they got you some how, they will just

*keep pounding on you no matter what.
Buy Terry had "Armor Plate" about him, he could take any thing that was dished out to him and give out as well and every time I'd call him at home to see what he'd been up to just or speak to him at the Ranch, he would remind me that he "Was Just Sitting in the Chair of Knowledge Looking Stupid!"
Terry was one of a kind, I was Fortunate, I was Privileged and Honored to have known him, a very Special Man. Thank You Terry for the Great Times!*
