Her students adored her, particularly for her unwavering commitment to teaching them to read, her enthusiasm for social studies and history, and her captivating stories from her experiences living abroad. Virginia's teaching extended beyond retirement as she

mentored and educated not only her students but also her caregivers and those in need.

Virginia's family was at the center of her heart. She was a loving mother, sister, aunt, and friend. Her devotion to her family instilled in her children a profound love for family, education, community, and each other, along with a strong sense of giving back. Her home was a welcoming haven, and her fun-loving spirit, wit, fearlessness, and zest for life were contagious. Above all else, Virginia showed great strength. She instilled in her children a fierce competitive nature to never yield and to never stop until the task is accomplished. Above all, she remained a devoted mother and teacher at heart. Virginia was a mother to many, always having extra room for whoever was in need at her table.

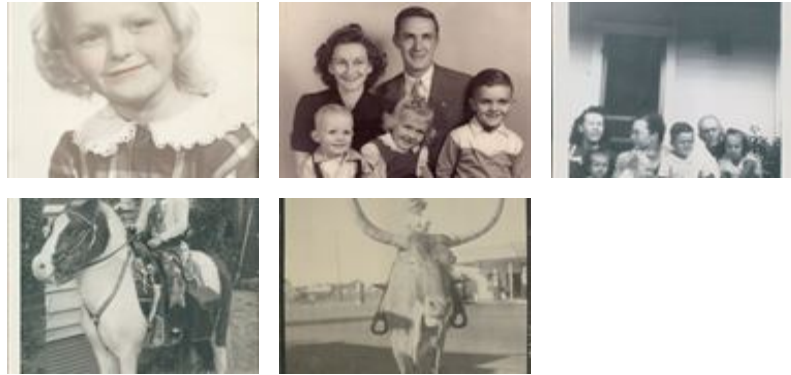
